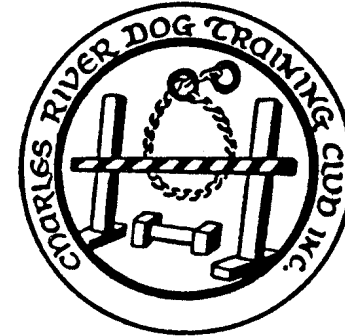

ENTRY FEES will not be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, or excused by the Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete because it is incorrectly entered. If because of riot, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open the show, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, judges, exhibitors and spectators. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

CLOSING DATE for entries 3:00 PM, Wednesday, October 28, 2009 (at Secretary's Home) after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

POST DATED CHECKS AND RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Subsequently returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. **CANADIAN** exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

BITCHES IN SEASON: A refund will be made for a bitch that comes into season after the Closing Date, provided that the request is accompanied by a Veterinarian's certificate and is received by the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging.
